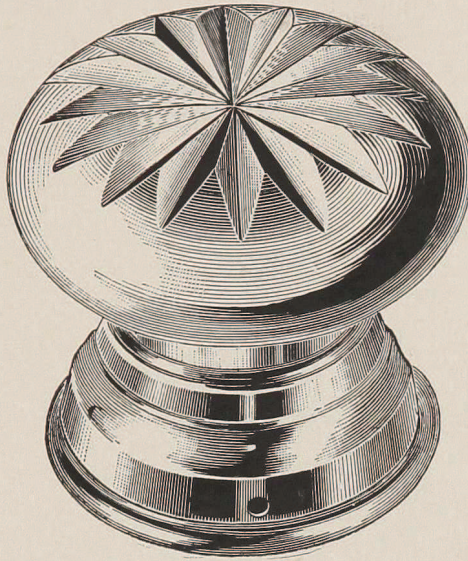
GLASS KNOBS.

THE universal revival of Colonial Architecture, and the furnishings of that period, has brought the old-fashion glass knob into favor again, and the manufacture of these goods has been renewed, with the addition of many new and handsome designs. For a number of years demand has been confined to metal knobs almost exclusively, but metal does not supply the required effect for such interiors.

Glass knobs, plain, engraved, cut, and pressed in various forms, are much better adapted for fine house fittings, also for handsome old dressers, desks, cabinets, and corner cupboards.

Trimmings are finished in gold, silver, nickel, brass, and antique bronze metals.

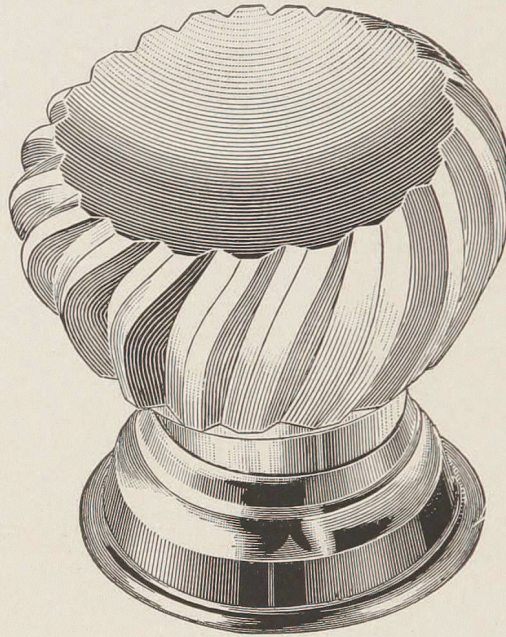

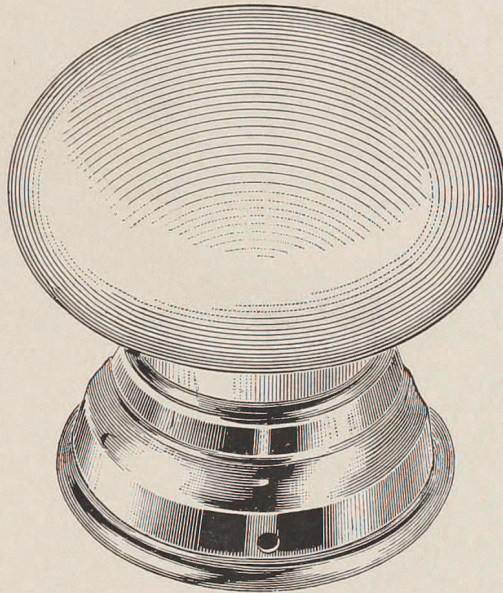
