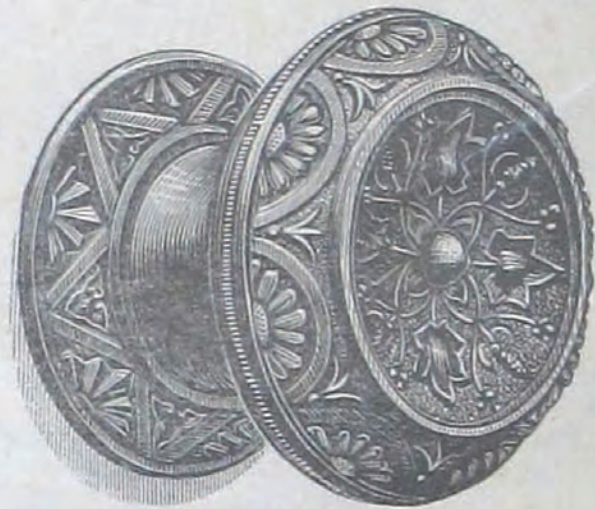


Door Knob No. 4, with Escutcheon No. 1.
