WELCOME TO ALBANY

GREETINGS TO ADCA MEMBERS 2022 ANNUAL ADCA CONVENTION

As we quickly found out last September in Albany after a year and a half of isolating and minimizing contact with many people, there is no substitute for real people, and equally important, being able to handle the hardware and actually talk to our friends face-to-face. This year we are back in the Midwest, and our host cities and hotel are outstanding choices.

Bloomington, Illinois was founded in 1831. Named in 1822 for its profusion of flowers, this charming city is steeped in education, Illinois State University and Illinois Wesleyan University. Franklin Avenue is shared with the bordering city of Normal, and is the only street in the nation with a university at each end.

Bloomington was the site of Abraham Lincoln's 1856 "Lost Speech" about the abolition of slavery, so named because reporters became so engrossed in the speech that no one took notes.

Famous Route 66 runs through Bloomington-Normal, where you will find a mix of historic experiences, capturing the feel of the "golden age" for the modern traveler. Be sure to take in Ryburn's Place at Sprague's Service Station, which opened in 1931. Now owned by the Town of Normal, it is on the National Register of Historic Places.

For animal lovers, The Miller Park Zoo is the place to go. A home to a variety of animals including a Sumatra Tiger, snow leopard, a sun bear, reindeer and several species of primates. For the young at heart, there is a carousel!

The Old House Society is a collectors dream...and a must. The Warehouse is filled with salvage items from homes in the Bloomington-Normal days gone by.

Peoria, Illinois is named after one of the five Illinois Native American tribes, and is reportedly the oldest settlement in the state. First settled in 1680, when French explorers Cavellier and de la Salle constructed Fort Creve Couer. The first American settlers arrived in 1819, and the city was incorporated in 1845.

Peoria is the county seat of Peoria County, Illinois and the largest city on the Illinois River, and features the Peoria Riverfront Museum offers a planetarium, a sculpture garden, a collection of fine art.

A trading and shipping center for a large agricultural area that produces corn, soybeans and livestock.

Peoria is the global headquarters of construction and mining equipment manufacturer, Caterpillar, Inc. Caterpillar has a museum that is open for tours.

Tour Days #1 (Bloomington-Normal) and Tour Day #2 (Peoria) have been planned with you in mind. Visits to historic houses, an award-winning brewery, a small museum filled with antique and collector autos, trains, airplanes, clocks, tractors - all gems from the past, and a restored 1864 residence which houses a gem and mineral museum

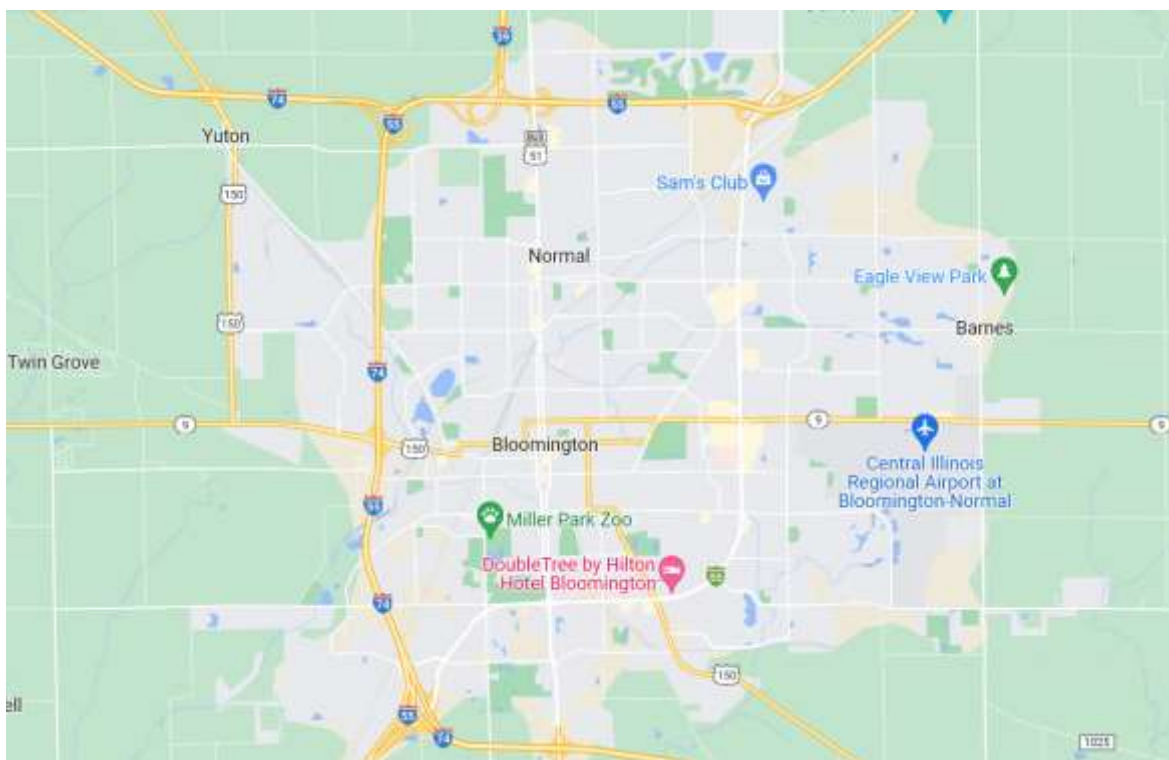

HOW TO GET TO BLOOMINGTON

There are several possible ways to get to Bloomington. Here are the alternatives:

1. By Air: Bloomington's airport is about 5 miles from the hotel, offering service by American, Delta, Allegiant, and Frontier. Peoria's airport is about 45 miles to the west and offers service by American, United and Allegiant. And Chicago's two airports are about 2 hours northeast of Bloomington, offering service by every airline.

2. By Train: Amtrak offers service from Chicago to their station in Normal, IL.

3. By Car: Bloomington is easily reached by several Interstate highways. From the far west I-70 comes into St. Louis. You drive right by the Gateway Arc before you connect with I-55 which goes north through Springfield to Bloomington. From Chicago in the north I-55 is a direct route. I-74 from Indianapolis connects with points east. I-74 connects with Peoria and on to I-80 for points in upper west. I-39 goes due north into Wisconsin.

Detailed Driving Directions to Doubletree Hotel by Hilton Bloomington

So, assuming you drive, set forth below are detailed directions to the hotel, Please note that if you are using a GPS, for best results enter this address: **10 Brickyard Drive Bloomington, IL 61701**

FROM BLOOMINGTON NORMAL AIRPORT: Exit the airport and turn left (west) onto E. Empire St. (Illinois State Route 9). Continue on E. Empire St., turn left onto Business I-55 south, Historic U.S. 66. Continue south, as the road turns west look for the Brickyard Drive stop light. Turn right onto Brickyard Dr. The hotel is just ahead.

FROM NORTH (Chicago) From I-55 take Business I-55 exit south, Historic U.S. 66, into Bloomington. Continue on Business I-55, as the road turns west look for the Brickyard Drive stop light. Turn right onto Brickyard Dr. The hotel is just ahead.

FROM NORTH (Rockport, IL.) Take I-39 to I-55. Go west on I-55, continue to the second (south) I-55, I-74 interchange. Take Business I-55 into Bloomington. Continue to Business I-55, Historic US 66, turn right onto Business I-55. Brickyard Dr. is the first stop light after the US 150 exit. Turn left onto Brickyard Dr. The hotel is just ahead.

FROM SOUTH AND EAST (Indianapolis) From I-74 take the Business US 51 exit north, South Main St. Continue to Business I-55, Historic US 66. Brickyard Dr. is the first stop light after the US 150 exit. Turn left onto Brickyard Dr. The hotel is just ahead.

FROM SOUTH AND WEST (St. Louis) From the far west I-70 comes into St. Louis. You drive right by the Gateway Arc before you connect with I-55 which goes north through Springfield to Bloomington. At the I-74, I-55 interchange take Business I-55 into Bloomington. Continue to Business I-55, Historic US 66. Brickyard Dr. is the first stop light after the US 150 exit. Turn left onto Brickyard Dr. The hotel is just ahead.

FROM NORTHWEST (Cedar Rapids, Peoria) I-80 connects to I-74 at Davenport, IL. Take I-74 south to Bloomington. At the I-55, I-74 interchange continue south on the joint I-55, I-74 to the south I-55, I-74 interchange. Take Business I-55 into Bloomington. Continue to Business I-55, Historic US 66. Brickyard Dr. is the first stop light after the US 150 exit. Turn left onto Brickyard Dr. The hotel is just ahead.

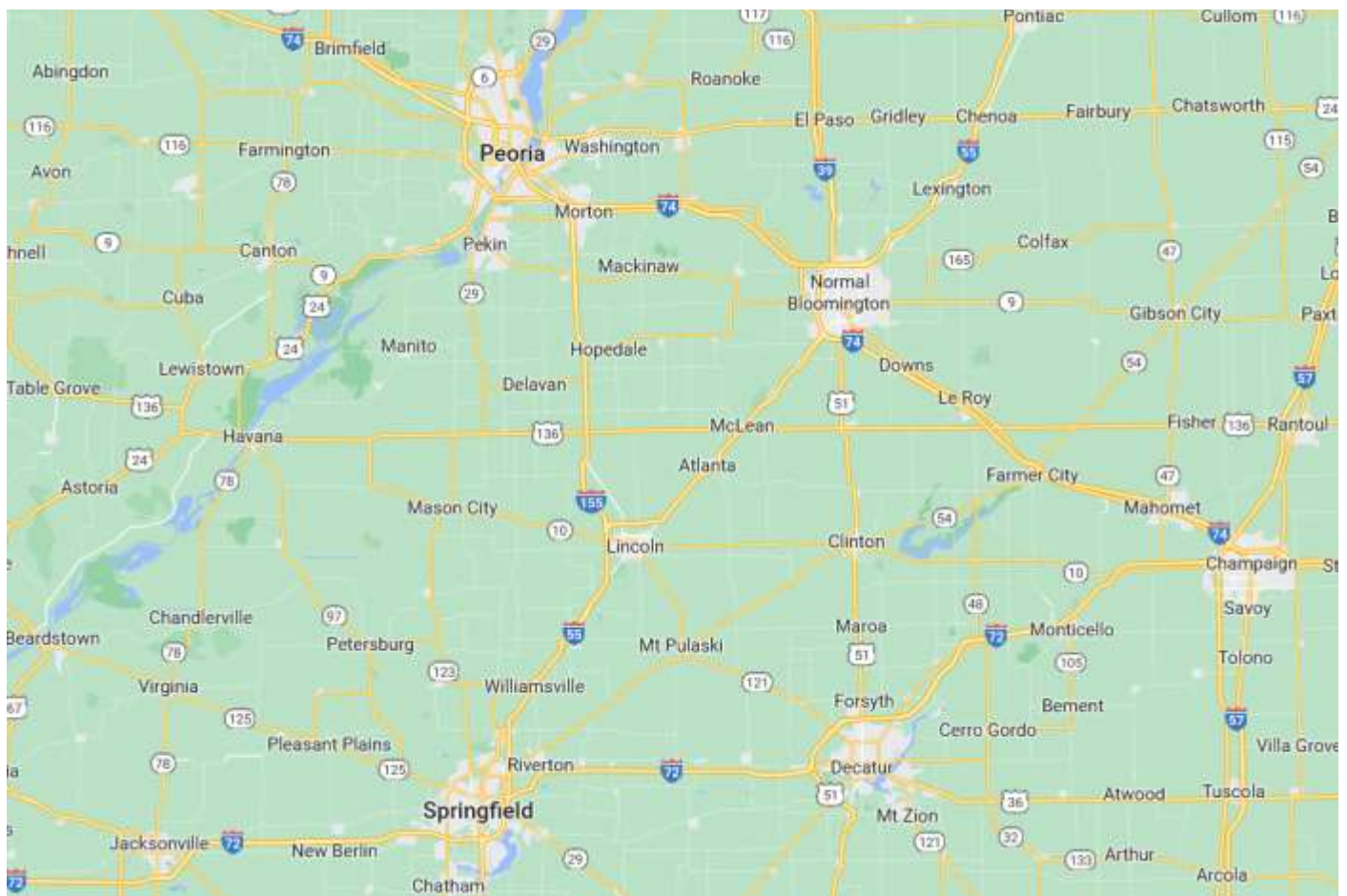
THINGS TO VISIT ON THE WAY

Lincoln Home National Historic Site: In Springfield, Illinois, <https://www.nps.gov/liho/index.htm>. Tours are available 9:00AM to 4:30PM Central Daylight time. Several other houses are part of the site.

Illinois State Capitol: In Springfield, Illinois is the 1888 Illinois State Capitol, designed by the same architect as the David Davis Mansion which we will tour on Wednesday. Dana-Thomas House: Also in Springfield, this is perhaps the most ornate home designed by architect Frank Lloyd Wright in the Prairie style. The home is perfectly preserved with original furnishings, many designed by Wright. <https://dana-thomas.org/>

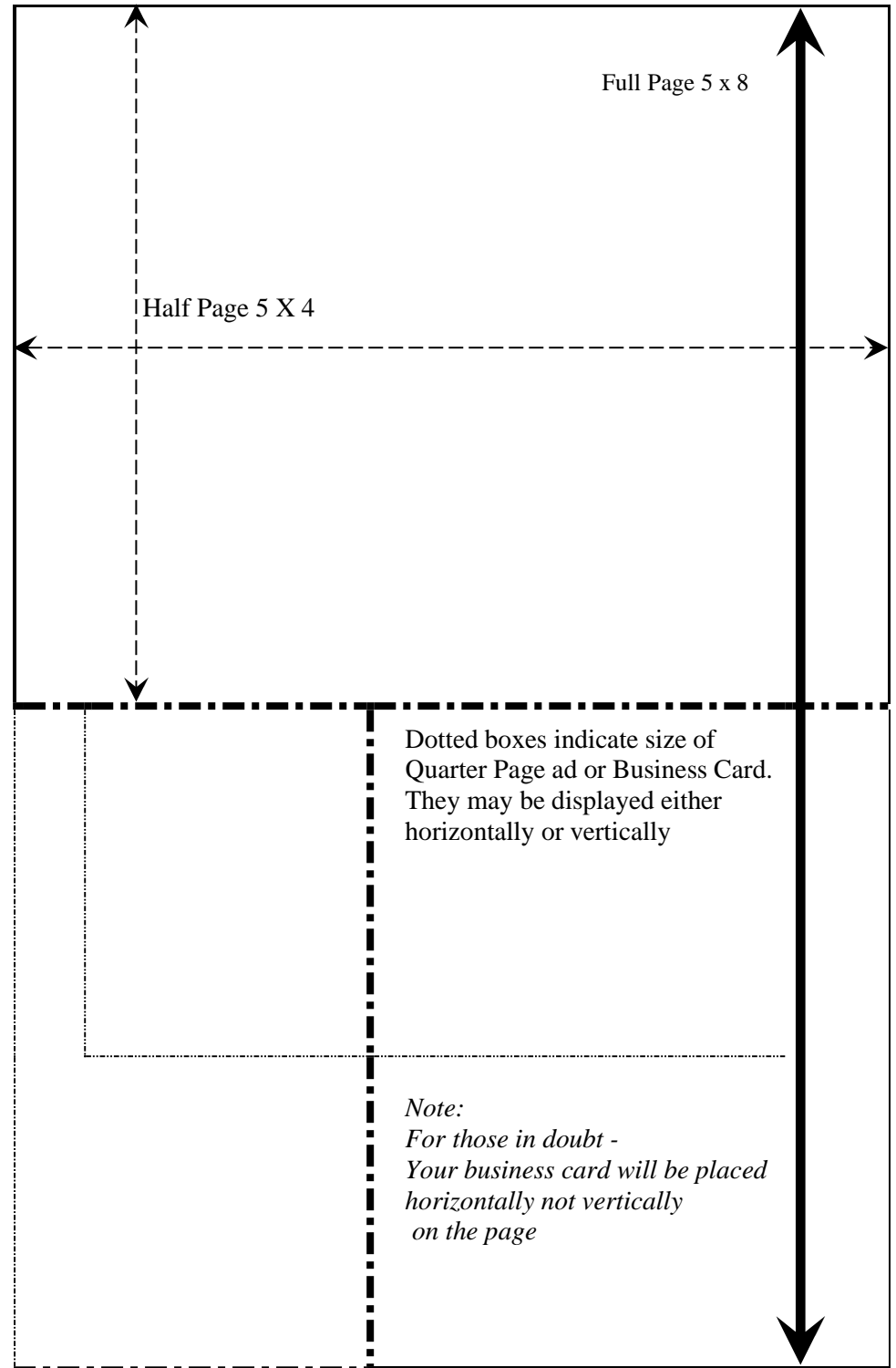
Please use the following guidelines to submit copy for inclusion in the souvenir program.
